Kambal-katinig

Ang salita ay may **kambal-katinig** kung ito ay may dalawang magkasunod na katinig sa isang pantig.

Halimbawa, ang kambal-katinig sa salitang **pluma** (plu-ma) ay ang **pl** dahil ito ay nasa unang pantig na *plu*. Ang salitang **petsa** ay walang kambal-katinig dahil ang **ts** ay hindi magkasama sa isang pantig. Kung pantigin ang salitang **petsa**, ito ay *pet-sa*.

May mga salita na may magkasunod na katinig ngunit walang kambal-katinig ang mga ito kapag ang dalawang katinig ay hindi magkasama sa isang pantig. Ang mga sumusunod ay mga halimbawa ng mga salitang *walang kambal-katinig*:
