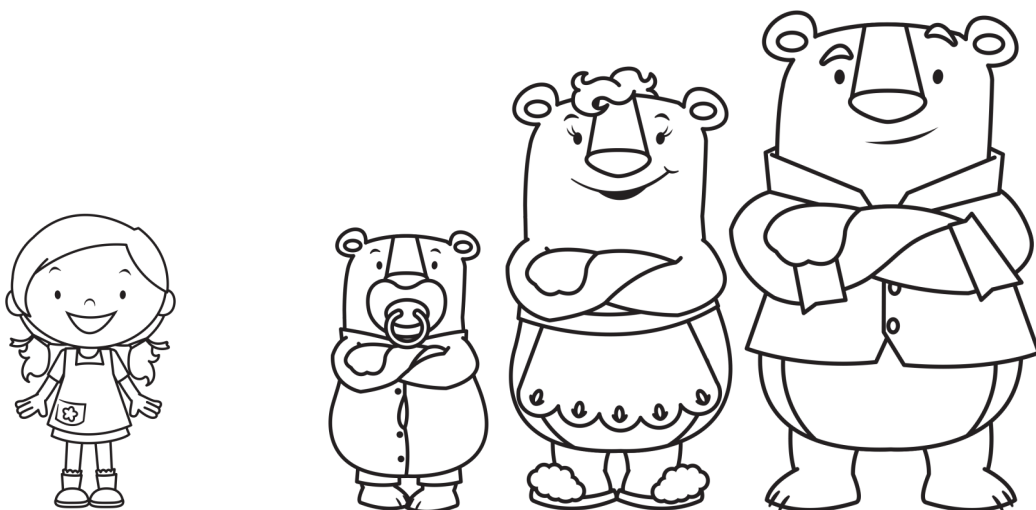

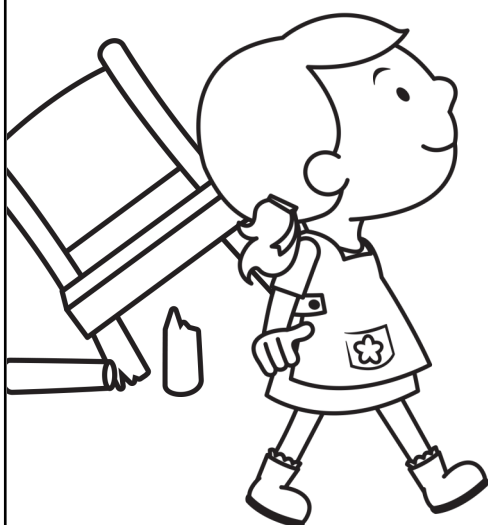

Umupo si Goldy sa upuan ni Mama Oso. “Napakalambot ng kutson,” sabi ni Goldy.

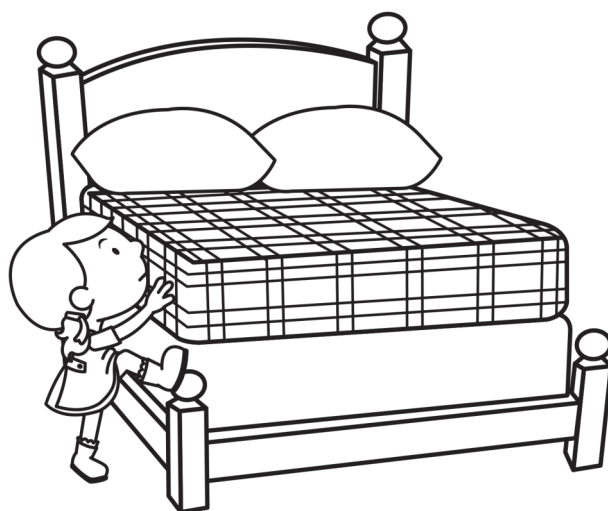
